

Good Morning Hermosa Church:

We pray all is well with each of you as our building, communities, county, state, and country continue to open back up from this shutdown due to the COVID-19 Pandemic. We are respectfully reminding each person to continue to protect themselves and their families as the virus continues to impact our nation and world.

Back on May 24, the decision was made to reopen our building for Sunday Morning worship. We have had four worship services with people back in the pews, or in our case chairs. Now, the next question is, when will we be able to open the building for Bible Class? The answer is this Sunday – June 21 – for the Auditorium Bible Class ONLY, which is an Adult Class taught by Jon Ross. Here are some items each of you will need to know for this coming Sunday:

1. The building will be open at 8:30 A.M. for those who want to come to Bible Class.
2. The building will be locked at 8:50 A.M., until 9:50 A.M., when the doors will be unlocked again for those who are coming for worship.
3. For those who choose to come to Bible Class, we ask that you find a seat in which you will be comfortable for both Bible Class and Worship. We know that we will be spread out throughout the auditorium, but we think this is best at this time.
4. If you have a question during class, please raise your hand, and a person with a microphone will come to you. We are doing this so those who are at home on the Livestream will be able to hear the question asked. Also, if you are watching on the Livestream, continue to submit your questions and Alan Williams, will relay those to Jon during class.
5. As for our kids, we are having a Bible Class for them on Wednesday evenings from 6:30 to 7:30 P.M. This class is designed for kids 18 and younger.
6. Last, we ask that everyone continue to show Agape Love and respect to each person. An example – you might be comfortable with hugging, shaking hands or even elbow bumping. However, not everyone is that comfortable at this point. So, ask everyone you see and most importantly just smile and be glad that we can worship with each other in the same building. Also, know that we still have some who are continuing to participate in Bible Class and worship through our Livestream services. Respect them, by calling them and checking on them during the week.

We are grateful to each one of you and ask that you be patient with each of us as we continue to work at opening back up after this shutdown.
